

## 2022 Christmas Climate Book Club Special Book List

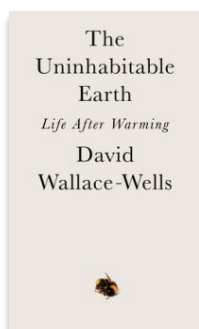
